Item 5/2015 Treasurer's Report

Copies of this years simplified account structure were handed out to Members present, included in these Minutes as <u>Annex A</u> and B and will also be posted on line. The headline figure is that the Association has total assets of £2,514.97, down from £2,730.02 from the previous year. This is comprised of £1,804.13 in the savings account and £710.84 in the current account.

This is considered a healthy enough balance bearing in mind that ALL major commitments have now been paid, i.e. the Centenary Silver Cup and Engraving. The Summer Social and Reunion Lunch, Dinner and Coach was overall expected to be self financing.

A letter had been received from "CALM", in thanks for the annual donation [£99 in 2014] made on behalf of the Members to this worthy designated XXIV Squadron charity. (See also Item 6/2015)

Ex Association Chairman, Richard Bates, has made a repeat offer [we had a previously successful visit in 2012] to host pre lunch drinks at his home in Blockley before moving onto The Crown, a short walk away for lunch.

Item 9c - Future Ladies Guest Nights. (from 2016)

Prompted by discussions with 30 and 48 Squadron Associations, it was put to the floor last AGM that consideration should be given to holding a Ladies Guest Night Dinner [LGN] off base, eg Reputable hotel, if this carried sufficient support. A special discount rate on rooms, inclusive of breakfast would be secured as part of the deal and separate from the cost of Dinner.

Consequently, an action was placed on the Secretary [Item 9c/2014] at last years AGM to survey the Members. The results were, 19 in favour of trying out the "Off base" format, 6 to remain at a Service Mess for Dinner. Taking that result as a mandate to progress the idea, the following is proposed.

The broad plan would be to have an optional informal meet up on the Friday evening at the Hotel for those living in the area or staying an extra day. All Members attending the Reunion rendezvous as normal at Brize for the AGM, lunch and daytime programme with the Squadron. Those attending the Ladies Guest Night [LGN] evening dinner would meet back at the nominated hotel. Squadron personnel would also be invited along to the hotel, as per a LGN in a Service Mess. This would save the need for a coach [£300+] and associated logistics and admin.

Item 12/2015 President's Remarks

Our new President was pleased to see quite a few new faces attending this years Reunion and trusted that trend would continue. Keith also asked that the AGM record a vote of thanks for another year of excellent work completed by the Committee.

A special mention to the Chairman for smoothing out the difficulties encountered as a result of the complex Centenary Dinner arrangements, the Treasurer for another set of understandable accounts and the outgoing Secretary, Dave Burgin for 22 continuous years in the post. His good use of modern technology has reduced running costs and brought the Association to the notice of the world wide web.

Item 13/2015 Any Other Business

Item 13.1 – Raffle Prize Donations. The Chairman thanked the many Members who had made donations to this year's raffle, with special mention to Colin Joyner for well crafted wooden puzzles. Post Meeting Note:- the AGM raffle raised £187 for Association funds.

Item 13.2 – Annual subscriptions. A query was raised by Brian Cowin as to whether the Treasurer thought that annual subscription where needed to bolster funds on top of the income from voluntary donations and raffles. The latest accounts, see Annex A, indicated that would not be necessary under the current forecast, as no more major expenses are planned.

The meeting closed at 12:15 hrs and Members moved back to join family and guests for the presentation of the Silver Cup to OC XXIV. The Wing Commander then proceeded to give a most interesting unscripted briefing on current Squadron operations and plans for the future.

A buffet lunch was served in the Mess Bar and afterwards Members and Guests joined the serving personnel of XXIV Squadron at the Families and Friends event staged around the Squadron HQ and A400M Training facility. Some seats were available for a flight in a C130J around the local and Bristol Channel area.
